#### COMPREHENSION:

**Directions (Q.38 to 42) Read the following passage to answer the given questions based on it.**

One of India's greatest footballers, this striker of the Indian team scored 65 goals in 84 international matches, captained the national team and was the country's top coach.

Born on June 23, 1936 in Mainaguri, located in the outskirts of Jalpaiguri, West Bengal, to Prabhat and Bina Banerjee. Pradeep Kumar Banerjee was enrolled first at the Jalpaiguri Zilla School.

In 1951, the 15-year-old began playing football officially in the right wing to represent Bihar in the Santosh Trophy, the nation's biggest annual inter-state soccer tournament. By 1954, Banerjee joined Aryan Football Club, one of Asia's oldest soccer clubs. Thereafter, he played for the Eastern Railway.

In 1956, Banerjee also made it to the Olympics in Melbourne, Australia. In the quarterfinals, Banerjee played a key role in India's 4-2 win over the team from the Olympic host.

In the Asian Games, Banerjee represented India thrice — in Tokyo (1958), Jakarta (1962) and Bangkok (1966). In 1962, during the Jakarta Games, India suffered a 0-2 defeat at the hands of South Korea.

In the 1960 Rome Olympics, Banerjee captained the Indian team and scored in the 1-1 draw against France. He represented India in the Merdeka Cup thrice — in 1964 and 1965, when India won the bronze medal, as well as in 1959 when it won the silver.

Frequent injuries hampered his career and finally in 1967, he decided to hang up his soccer boots.

Banerjee began coaching the East Bengal Club. Later, under his guidance, Mohan Bagan won the historic the IFA Shield, Rover Cup and Durand Cup in just one season. In 1972, he assumed charge as the coach of the national team. Banerjee's first match as the coach was a qualifier for the Munich Olympics. He continued to coach the national football team till 1986. Thereafter, from 1991 to 1997, he was the technical director of the Tata Football Academy in Jamshedpur. In 1999, Banerjee was again hired for the post of the technical director of the Indian football team.

Awards and recognition galore, including the FIFA Order of Merit (highest honour by FIFA) in 2004 and the Padma Shri Award in 1990, deservedly came Banerjee's way. He was also named India's Footballer of the 20th Century by the International Federation of Football History & Statistics.

On March 20, 2020, Banerjee, after a prolonged illness, passed away in Kolkata. He is survived by his younger brother Prasun Banerjee and his daughters Purna and Paula, who are academicians.
